Board of Trustees Meeting
12 September 2019

The Regular Board of Trustees meeting was held on 12 September 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Center. Roll call: Deer-present, Estes-absent, Henderson-present, Ponton-present, Seidelman-present, Spaulding-absent, Bayler-present.

Motion by Henderson, 2nd by Seidelman to approve the agenda. Voice Vote: all yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Seidelman, 2nd by Henderson to approve minutes from the prior meetings. Voice vote: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Jason Wascher asked what the Village was doing in regards to properties that need mowed and trimmed, have garbage and multiple broken down mowers on them and those that have numerous vehicles parked in front of them. He stated there are properties that have vehicles and campers that haven't been moved in a long time, properties that have vehicles parked in the yard along with Demo Cars. Chief Bein stated that he has already given notices to some property owners and some have started to clean up their yards but he has a procedure he has to follow. He also asked about the noise ordinance in town regarding dirt bikes and 4 wheelers. He stated he would like to see something done with all of this.

Village Presidents Report: President Bayler spoke on the cannabis memo that was sent out to the board from attorney Marc Miller. A public hearing was set for 6:00 pm on September 25th to discuss the possible sale of cannabis within the Village.

Village Administrator Report was given.

Motion by Deer, 2nd by Seidelman to approve Resolution 2019-R-1 authorizing the Champaign County HMP project manger to act as the representative for the Village of Fisher at planning meetings during the update process of the Champaign County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. Voice vote: all yes. Motion carried.
