Signed Waiver of liability by applicant releasing the Village and agreeing to indemnify and hold the Village harmless from any and all future claims resulting from the operation of his/her golf carts on Village streets.

Photocopy of applicable liability insurance coverage card specifically for the vehicle to be operated pursuant to the permit.

Such other information as the Village may require.

No permit shall be granted unless the following conditions are met:

The golf cart must be inspected by the designated representative to ensure that the golf cart is safe to operate on Village streets.

A physically handicapped applicant must submit a certificate signed by a physician, certifying that the applicant is able to safely operate a qualified golf cart on Village streets.

The applicant must provide evidence of insurance in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois Statutes regarding minimum liability insurance.

The Village may suspend or revoke a permit granted hereunder upon a finding that the holder thereof has violated any provision of this Ordinance or there is evidence that the permittee cannot safely operate a qualified golf cart on the designated roadways.

Failure to abide by this Ordinance shall result in the fine of \$100.00, with each infraction of this Ordinance constituting a separate offense bearing a separate fine.
