Domestic Chicken License Application

Requirements for Obtaining License per Ordinance 3-1-1(A)

- 1. No roosters permitted. No more than Six (6) hens permitted
- 2. Shall be kept in designated Coop or Run. No running at large permitted.
- 3. Coop or run shall be located in a rear yard of single family residence. Shall not be closer than 5 (five) feet from the rear or side lot line of property. Must not be closer than 25 (twenty-five) feet of neighboring dwellings.
- Coop or Run must be enclosed on all sides, including the top or roof plane. Shall not
 exceed 120 (one-hundred-twenty) square feet, unless a permit has been issued by the
 Building Inspector.
- Coop or Run shall be kept clean, dry, and sanitary at all times. Manure, uneaten or discarded feed, feathers and waste must be removed regularly. Chicken waste shall not be disposed of with regular household garbage.
