Travis Wilson, Lincoln Street resident, asked questions regarding setback requirements of this amendment. The current setbacks outlined in the Zoning Ordinance would be in force for installation of solar arrays.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Committee discussed the proposed amendment and suggested changing the 6-foot requirement for both the solar array and fencing to 7 feet.

The Committee voted 5 to 0 to approve and forward to the Village Board the amendment to the Zoning Ordinance that places limitations on ground mounted solar array within the Village limits with the following change: ground installed solar arrays may not exceed seven (7) feet in height and provided that said ground installed solar arrays are entirely enclosed by solid and opaque fencing, said fencing to not be less than seven (7) in height.
